Horse Feeding Notes

- ... Provide clean, fresh water, salt and mineral at all times except immediately following exercise when the horse is hot.
- ...Feed a minimum of 1-2 lbs of forage per 100 lbs of body weight daily. Forage is the foundation of any horse feeding program.
- ...Adjust feed intake to maintain desired body weight and condition. Intake will vary depending upon season, activity level, age of horse, and quality of forage in the diet.
- ...Feed by weight, not by volume. For example, one quart of oats will weigh approximately 1 lb while one quart of cracked corn will weigh approximately 1.7 lbs.
- ...The horse digestive system is designed to utilize small amounts of grain at a time. DO NOT feed more than 5 lbs of grain in a single feeding.
- ...All new feed changes should be gradually made over a 6-10 day period.

Elite Maintenance

Our original 10% sweet feed containing steam processed grains and soybean meal. A very good choice as a general purpose feed for pasture horses and mature horses with light to moderate activity.

Elite Original

Our popular high fat, reduced carbohydrate feed. A favorite for those horses needing a low level of starch. Also helps to put weight and bloom on hard keepers. A great choice for performance and show horses.

Elite Pleasure

One of our most popular feeds. This feed is designed for the average horse that is either in light work or on pasture. Also appropriate for broodmares in their first few months of gestation.



Elite Performance

A special formula with no corn for those horse owners who prefer not to feed corn. Plenty of fiber and fat is available from other non corn feed ingredients to ensure adequate energy.

Elite Competitor

A performance feed that contains extra nutrients for the higher demands of show horses, 2 year olds in training, stallions or broodmares. Features steam processed grains and fat from roasted soybeans.

Elite Senior

A high protein and high fat feed formulated for the needs of the senior horse. A calorie dense feed that is high in fermentable fiber to promote proper gut function. Fully fortified with essential minerals and vitamins including added biotin.

Elite Pelleted Feeds

Elite 10%

A value-added pellet for active mature horses. An excellent choice when a pelleted feed is desired and the horse has access to good quality forages.

Elite Lite

A pellet made especially for ponies, miniature horses and "easy keepers" predisposed to heavy condition. Very condensed formula requires a low feeding rate. Contains low starch and high fiber.

Elite Complete

A complete and balanced pellet to meet the needs of mature horses. Contains high quality fiber. A good choice for horses that do not have adequate pasture or when hay is in short supply. Always feed hay or pasture equivalent at the rate of 1-2 lbs. per 100 lbs. of bodyweight.



Elite Balancer

A supplemental choice to ensure horses meet their nutritional needs on a diet consisting primarily of forages. A dense source of vitamins, minerals, and protein. Can be used to create a balanced diet when individual grains are being fed to horses of various ages and activity.

Elite 14%

Uses the same technology as Elite 10% but with added protein for pregnant mares, lactating mares, foals, growing horses and for performance horses.

Elite Fiber Blend

A fiber supplement to a horse's diet during times of limited availability of hay and grazeable forages. Helps to stretch the supply of existing forage sources when they are short.
