Repair and maintain gasoline engines used to power equipment such as portable saws, lawn mowers, generators, and compressors.

## **Job Description**

#### **ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS**

- Obtain problem descriptions from customers, and prepare cost estimate for repairs.
- Dismantle small engines, using hand tools, and examine for defects.
- Test and inspect engines to determine malfunctions, to locate missing and broken parts, and to verify repairs, using diagnostic instruments.
- Repair or replace defective parts such as gears, pistons, and carburetors, using hand tools
- Perform routine maintenance such as cleaning and oiling parts, honing cylinders, and tuning ignition systems.
- Reassemble engines after repair or maintenance work is complete.
- Adjust points, valves, carburetors, distributors, and spark plug gaps, using feeler gauges.
- Replace motors.
- Accurately record repairs made, time spend, and parts used.
- Demonstrate to customers how to maintain equipment.
- Remove engine from equipment, and position and bolt engines to repair stands.
- Grind, re-bore, and re-tap parts to obtain specified clearances, using grinders, lathes, taps, boring machines, and micrometers.
