Ingredients

Cane molasses, cottonseed meal, corn gluten meal, ammonium chloride, hydrolyzed vegetable fat, monocalcium phosphate, dicalcium phosphate, magnesium oxide, limestone, zinc sulfate, manganese sulfate, copper chloride, sodium selenite, ethylenediamine dihydrodioxide, cobalt carbonate, vitamin A acetate, vitamin D₃ Supplement, and vitamin E supplement.

Feeding Directions

Feed Co-op 18% Goat supplement bucket to goats consuming medium to lower quality pasture, hay, or forage. Place bucket(s) in a dry location near the animals' source of water, salt, mineral, or loafing area. Consumption will vary depending on animal size, stage of production, quality, source, and availability of roughage and/or grains; number of animals per tub and tub location.

DAILY INTAKE VALUES ARE APPROXIMATE. To increase consumption, decrease the number of animals per bucket. To reduce consumption increase the number of animals per bucket, or place buckets away from the normal loafing area.

To feed, remove the plastic cover and score surface several times with a knife to encourage initial consumption.

Do not stack anything on top of this bucket without placing a slip sheet or wooden pallet between the buckets.

Provide clean, fresh water at all times, plus free-choice salt.
