## Ingredients

Cane molasses, processed grain by-products, cottonseed meal, hydrolyzed vegetable fat, monocalcium phosphate, dicalcium phosphate, limestone, zinc sulfate, manganese sulfate, calcium carbonate, sodium selenite, magnesium oxide, ethylenediamine dihydriodide, cobalt carbonate, vitamin A acetate, vitamin D<sub>3</sub> supplement, and vitamin E supplement.

## Feeding Directions

Feed Co-op 15% Sheep supplement to ewes before breeding and lambing, and to all sheep on medium to low quality pasture, hay, or forage. Place tub(s) in a dry location ear the animal's source of water, salt, mineral, or loafing area.

Consumption will vary depending on animal size, stage of production, quality, source, and availability of roughage and/or grains; number of animals per tub and tub location.

DAILY INTAKE VALUES ARE APPROXIMATE. To increase consumption, decrease the number of animals per bucket. To reduce consumption increase the number of animals per bucket, or place buckets away from the normal loafing area.

To feed, remove the plastic cover and score surface several times with a knife to encourage initial consumption.

Do not stack anything on top of this bucket without placing a slip sheet or wooden pallet between the buckets.

Provide clean, fresh water at all times, plus free-choice salt.
